Issue Tracker

Summary

This is a little introduction to the issue tracker.

1. Create an account for yourself, using your William and Mary userid as your username.
You must do this by 5pm Saturday.

The following must be done after 8pm Saturday.

3. Between 5pm and 8pm Saturday, I will give everyone developer permissions. This will allow you to create and edit tasks.
4. Go to permissions, and set it so that the issue tracker shows you the points for each issue. (You can also have it show who is assigned to a task, difficulty, etc.)
5. Sign yourself up for the “Free points” task. Be careful to hold CTRL while selecting your name in the list, or you will unselect everyone else’s!
6. Go to reports, and tell it to show you the “performance score” for the developers group.
7. Create a text file. In this file answer the following questions:
 - 1) Where did you get your individual points?
 - 2) Why didn’t you get points for the “Homework 1” task?
8. Find the issue in the issues list entitled “Homework 1”. Add an event to the issue with a little description. Also attach your text file to the event.
9. Register your userid in the class discussion forum
